Formats of Classes

We do expect you to be working during class time just like at school. You will be able to submit images that the instructor can review both during class and also before the next class begins.

Bargue students will continue the work on their current bargues or begin a new one at home if needed. Or we can give you a digital file with info for ordering. Again, if you need a new one at any time throughout the term, we can arrange for you to come pick up a new bargue. In certain rare circumstances Julie may be able to

deliver it if you are unable to leave. Please reach out. Cast/Still life students will be discussing their at-home capabilities with the instructor the first day of class and determining an appropriate project to work on this term, or continuing from the previous term.




